We care about the safety of our members, our staff, and our associated communities and have established the following safety protocols.

- ACUA encourages attendees to review and follow CDC guidance for domestic travel. (https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/travel-during-covid19.html)
- We will be setting up our sessions to encourage social distancing.
- Through the use of color-coded badges, attendees will be able to communicate their comfort level with social distancing (Green: Ok to Contact/hug or handshake); Yellow (Minimal Contact – fist bump); Red (Do Not Contact – no close interaction).
- Following the city of Raleigh's regulations, masks will be welcomed but not required indoors, unless specifically stated.
- ACUA will make masks and hand sanitizer available upon conference check-in.
- If you're sick, please stay home.
